

In 1982, the bank expanded into Sedalia, with the facility at 1601 South Limit, where it currently resides today! A couple decades later, the Bank was purchased by Warren County Bancshares in 1999 and then merged into The Missouri Bank in April 2020.

With our five officers totaling over 145 years of experience, and some additional employees with over 20 years of experience, shows our commitment to our clientele and our promise to serve Sedalia with consistency.

The Missouri Bank Gives Back

Since the inception of TMB's "Denim for Donations" in October 2020, we have raised over \$7,750 for non-profit organizations in our communities. So, each Friday, our employees get the opportunity to wear jeans for a small donation. Every month, each location gets to choose where our designated raised funds will be donated. We've donated to a senior citizens center, front line families, child advocacy center, equine therapy and more!

For the month of May, we donated \$718 to The Mercy Rest Stop in Sedalia! Once their facility is completed, it will allow a site to offer 24/7 sanitary restrooms, 24/7 water source, laundry facility, and a cooling/warming station for safe escape from severe weather. They will have professionals available to assist with many issues, such a mental, physical health, and/or addiction.

The Hermann branch chose to donate our June funds to the Franklin County CASA, Inc.! They advocate for the best interest of children of abuse and neglect who are under the protection of the Franklin County and Gasconade County Juvenile Courts. We raised \$787 for CASA.

\$793 was donated to "Do Something Right Now (DSRN) Inc." in Columbia. DSRN's goal is to partner with residents (children, parents, seniors and veterans) of underprivileged neighborhoods, donors, volunteers and existing community resources to promote equity through the development of strong families, thriving children and safe, positive living and learning environments. Their current project is the development of a community empowerment center called Hogan House.
